Take Notice that Donegal County Council proposes to carry out the following development on the existing N15 National Primary Road in the urban environs of Lifford located in the Lifford / Stranorlar Municipal District as detailed in the schedule below:

**Description and Extents**

Donegal County Council proposes to provide a new shared use pedestrian and cyclist facility adjacent to the existing N15 National Primary Road in accordance with the Part 8 application.

The project will include:

- Provision of a shared use cycle / pedestrian facility on the northern side of the existing N15.
- Reduction in mainline road width and reallocation of space to the shared facility within the scheme extents.
- Provision of appropriate road crossings both controlled and uncontrolled within the scheme extents.
- Provision of upgraded public street lighting within the scheme extents.
- Provision of all appropriate drainage, earthworks, road marking and road signage for the project.
- Minor localised realignment of the existing roads, accesses, and junctions to accommodate the new facility.
- All other ancillary and tie in works to TII, DMURS and National Cycle Manual standards.
