DRÉACHT FODHLÍTHE CHOMHAIRLE CONTAE DHÚN NA NGALL (DRAMHAÍL COIS COSÁIN A CHUR AMACH DON BHAILIÚ), 2024

Tá sé i gceist ag Comhairle Contae Dhún na nGall, chun críche an dea-bhainistíú dramhaíola agus coisceadh nó smachtú an truaillithe timpeallachta, Fodhlíthe a cheapadh faoi Alt 35(1) den Acht um Bhainistíú Dramhaíola 1996. Cuirfidh na Fodhlíthe seo, ach a rithfear iad, de cheangal ar an té a bhfuil dramhaíl tí nó tráchtála aige an dramhaíl sin a chur amach le haghaidh a bailithe nó a thabhairt chuig saoráid de réir na bhFodhlíthe seo.

Pléann na Fodhlíthe le scaradh, stóráil, cur amach agus bailiú na gcineálacha éagsúla dramhaíola. Beidh aon duine a shróidh na Fodhlíthe seo ciontach i gcion agus gearrfar pionós orthu mar atá leagtha amach sna Dréacht-Fodhlíthe.

Beidh tosach feidhme in 2024 leis na Fo-dhlíthe, ach a rithfear iad.

Beidh cóip de na fodhlíthe ar fáil le haghaidh Breithniú Poiblí ar <https://consult.donegal.ie> agus chomh maith leis sin in Ionaid Seirbhísí Poiblí Chomhairle Contae Dhún na nGall go ceann dhá mhí, ón Déardaoin an 28ú Márta 2024 go dtí an Mháirt an 28ú Bealtaine, agus beidh siad ar fáil saor in aisce.

DRAFT DONEGAL COUNTY COUNCIL (PRESENTATION OF KERBSIDE WASTE FOR COLLECTION) BYE-LAWS, 2024

Donegal County Council propose that for the purpose of the proper management of waste and for the prevention or control of environmental pollution to make Bye-laws under Section 35(1) of the Waste Management Act 1996. These Bye-laws, if made, will require the holder of household or commercial waste to present that waste for collection or bring it to a facility in accordance with the Bye-laws.

The Bye-laws address segregation, storage, presentation and collection of the different types of waste. Any person who contravenes these Bye-laws shall be guilty of an offence and will be liable to penalties as set out in the draft Bye-laws.

The Bye-laws, if made, will commence in 2024.

A copy of the draft Bye-laws will be available for Public Inspection at <https://consult.donegal.ie> and also in Donegal County Council Public Services Centres for a period of two months, from the Thursday 28th March 2024 to Tuesday 28th May 2024 and can be provided free of charge.
